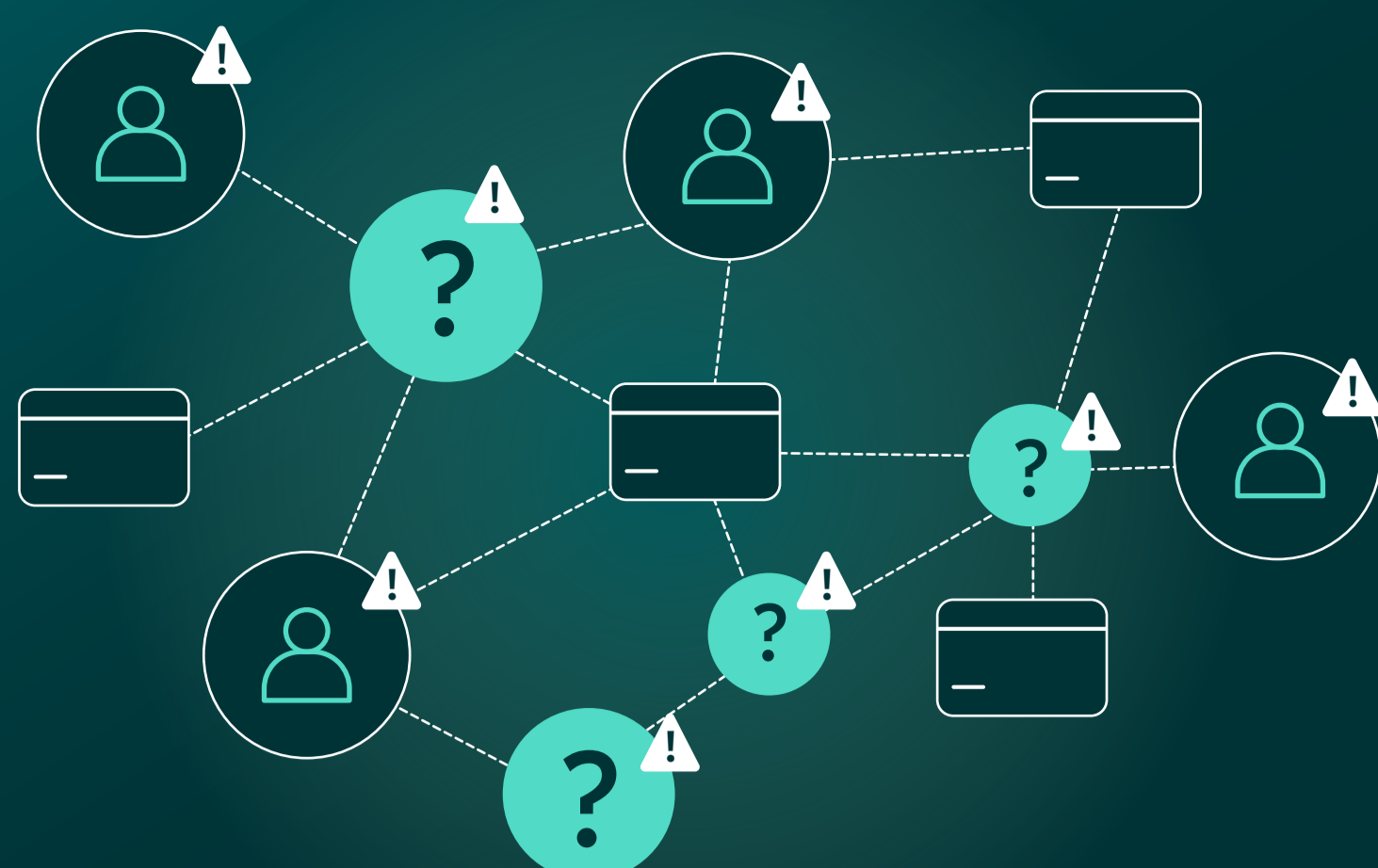

Digital asset markets still struggle to verify organizational identity, authority, and accountability at scale.

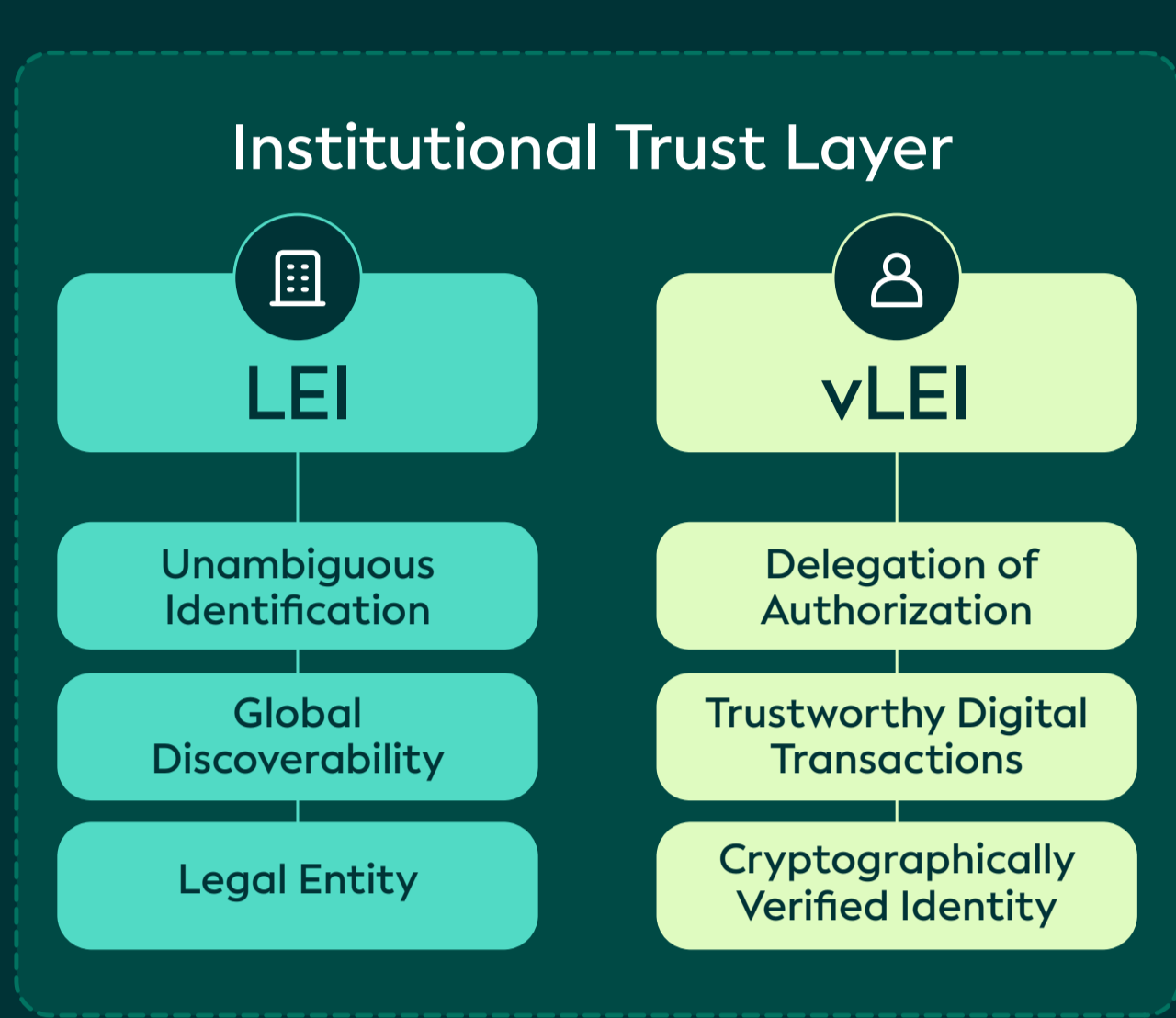
### Digital Asset

With the vLEI standardized under ISO 17442-3, digital asset markets now have a standards-based way to verify organizational identity, role, and authority.



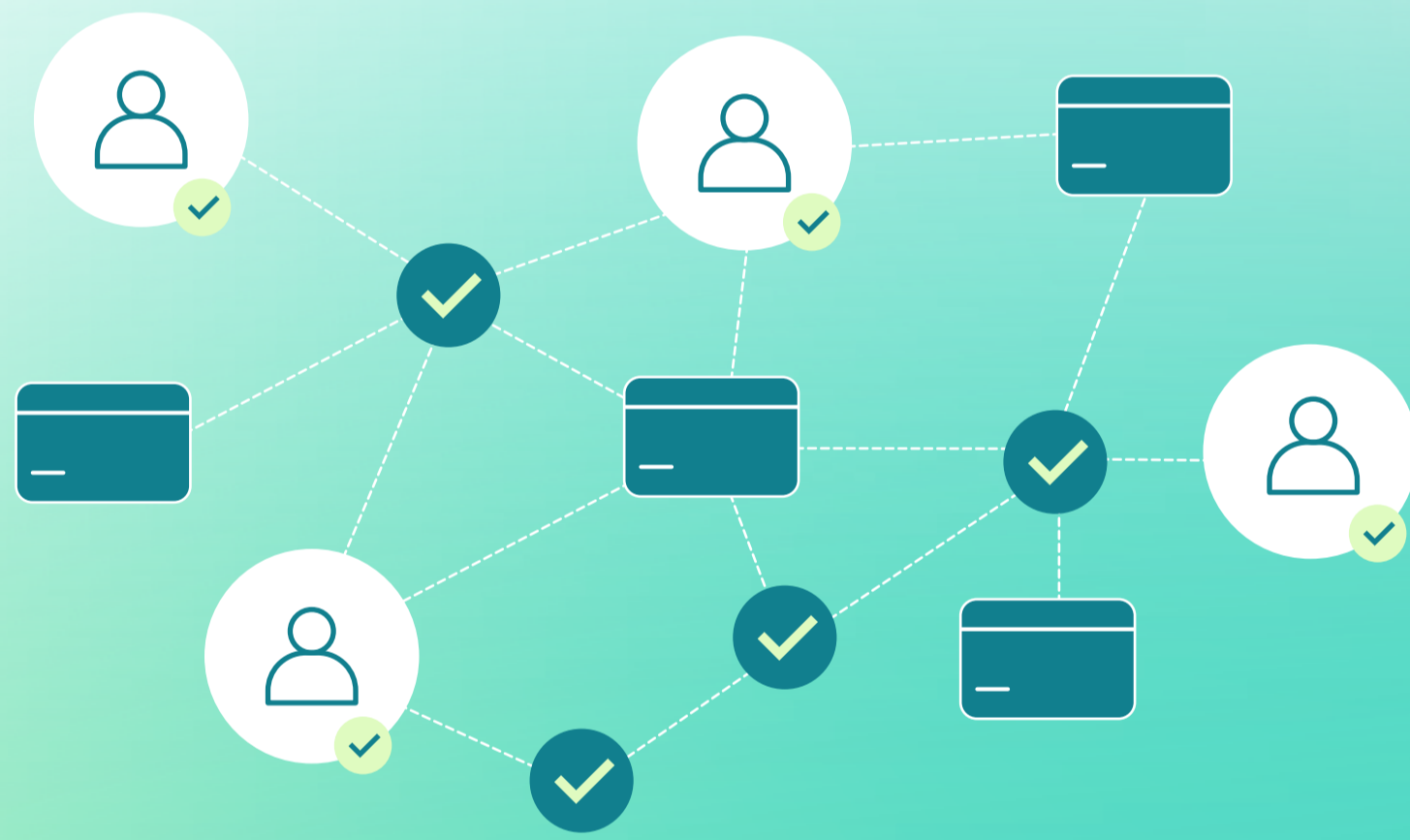
The LEI and vLEI connect traditional finance and digital assets through a shared, trusted identity layer.

The LEI and vLEI provide a globally recognized foundation for secure digital transactions:



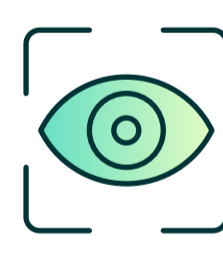
### Global standards
